### LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-365

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult "with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation" and to consult "on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council"; and

WHEREAS,the Indian Health Service established the National Tribal Advisory Committee<br/>on Behavioral Health ("NTAC") to enhance the government-to-government<br/>relationship and the effort of the Division of Behavioral Health to improve<br/>service delivery within Indian Country (NTAC Mission Statement); and

WHEREAS,the "NTAC helps guide the development of, and support for, behavioral health<br/>throughout the IHS/Tribal/Urban (ITU) systems, and work to ensure that<br/>services are as broadly integrated, available and culturally appropriate as<br/>possible" (National Indian Health Board, available at:<br/>http://www.nihb.org/behavioral\_health/ntac\_ihs.php); and

WHEREAS, NTAC's membership consists of 12 elected tribal officials representing each Indian Health Service ("IHS") Area with each Area Director selecting two members to represent the Area on NTAC, one nominee to serve as the primary representative and the other as alternate; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the NTAC's Charter, nominees must be elected tribal leaders or be selected by tribal Leaders; and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends nominating Representative Arthur Wilson for appointments as the primary NTAC Area representative and Representative Loretta Lewis as Representative Arthur Wilson's alternate.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:

- (1) nominates Representative Arthur Wilson for appointment as the primary NTAC Area representative and Representative Loretta Lewis as Representative Arthur Wilson's alternate; and
- (2) requests that the Tucson Area Director select Representative Arthur Wilson as the primary NTAC Area representative and Representative Loretta Lewis as Representative Arthur Wilson's alternate.
