

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Nominating Representative Arthur Wilson as Primary Representative and**  
**Representative Loretta Lewis as Alternate to the Indian Health Service**  
**National Tribal Advisory Committee on Behavioral Health)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-365**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult**  
2 **“with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal agencies**  
3 **regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation” and to**  
4 **consult “on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local**  
5 **governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or**  
6 **political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters**  
7 **within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council”;** and

8 **WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service established the National Tribal Advisory Committee**  
9 **on Behavioral Health (“NTAC”) to enhance the government-to-government**  
10 **relationship and the effort of the Division of Behavioral Health to improve**  
11 **service delivery within Indian Country (NTAC Mission Statement); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the “NTAC helps guide the development of, and support for, behavioral health**  
13 **throughout the IHS/Tribal/Urban (ITU) systems, and work to ensure that**  
14 **services are as broadly integrated, available and culturally appropriate as**  
15 **possible” (National Indian Health Board, available at:**  
16 **[http://www.nihb.org/behavioral\\_health/ntac\\_ihs.php](http://www.nihb.org/behavioral_health/ntac_ihs.php)); and**

17 **WHEREAS, NTAC's membership consists of 12 elected tribal officials representing each**  
18 **Indian Health Service (“IHS”) Area with each Area Director selecting two**  
19 **members to represent the Area on NTAC, one nominee to serve as the primary**  
20 **representative and the other as alternate; and**

21 **WHEREAS, in accordance with the NTAC's Charter, nominees must be elected tribal leaders**  
22 **or be selected by tribal Leaders; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends nominating**  
24 **Representative Arthur Wilson for appointments as the primary NTAC Area**  
25 **representative and Representative Loretta Lewis as Representative Arthur**  
26 **Wilson's alternate.**

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

28 **(1) nominates Representative Arthur Wilson for appointment as the primary**  
29 **NTAC Area representative and Representative Loretta Lewis as**  
30 **Representative Arthur Wilson's alternate; and**

31 **(2) requests that the Tucson Area Director select Representative Arthur Wilson**  
32 **as the primary NTAC Area representative and Representative Loretta Lewis**  
33 **as Representative Arthur Wilson's alternate.**

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that an appointment made pursuant to this resolution shall**  
2 **supersede any prior appointment to NTAC and shall immediately expire if the**  
3 **appointed representative no longer serves on the Health and Human Services**  
4 **Committee for any reason.**

5 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
6 **SEPTEMBER, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0-**  
7 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
8 **Article VI, Section 1(b), 1(c)(2), 1(f) and 1(j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
9 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
10 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**  
11 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
