LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Reducing Length of Suspension)

DEFEATED LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 13-373

1	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is exclusively vested with the power to appoint and
2		remove the Nation's judges (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article
3		VIII, Sections 3 and 4, and Article XIII, Sections 1 and 3) and:
4	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court's jurisdiction to review Legislative Council
5		removal proceedings is "extremely limited," Francisco v. Manuel, 89-WM-4664 at
6		9 (T.O.Jud.Ct. Nov. 9, 1989); "There is, after all, no right to hold office." Enos
7		Francisco, Jr. v. Legislative Council, (Trial Ct., Mar 7, 1989) 1 Tohono O'odham
8		Reports 76, 77; and
9	WHEREAS,	In addition to possessing the power to appoint and remove, the Legislative
10		Council is vested with the poWer to suspend Nation's judges from office for
11		criminal conduct, gross neglect of duty, and other grounds, subject to a
12		reasonable cause determination by the Judiciary Committee and a final
13		determination by the Legislative Council (6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4 –
14		Suspension of Judges); and
15	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council Judiciary Committee is vested with authority to
16		determine whether "there is reasonable cause to believe that the accused judge
17		has committed as offense for which suspension is available as charged in the
18		suspension statement" (6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, Section 4104); and
19	WHEREAS,	on August 5, 2013 Chief Judge Violet Lui-Frank filed with the Judiciary
20		Committee chairperson an Amended Suspension Statement requesting the
21		suspension of Judge Larry K. Yazzie pursuant to 6 Tohono O'odham Code
22	i	Chapter 4, Section 4103; and
23	WHEREAS,	after providing written notice of its reasonable cause hearing date, a copy of the
24		Amended Suspension Statement, and the Judicial Suspension Reasonable Cause
25		Hearing Procedures to both parties, the Judiciary Committee conducted a
26		suspension reasonable cause hearing on August 27-28, 2013 in accordance with
27		the provisions of 6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, Section 4104; and
28	WHEREAS,	after deliberations, the Judiciary Committee found reasonable cause that Judge
29		Yazzie committed conduct contrary to justice, honesty, modesty or good morals
30		and misconduct reflecting on the dignity and integrity of the Judicial Court as
31		charged in the Amended Suspension Statement; and
32	WHEREAS,	on September 4, 2013, the Legislative Council Secretary served the parties with
33		the Judiciary Committee's reasonable cause resolutions, written notice of the
34		Legislative Council's September 17, 2013 suspension hearing, the Amended

Suspension Statement, and the Council's Judicial Suspension Hearing Procedures; and

Judge Yazzie was represented by an attorney, given the opportunity to file motions, be present at the hearing, testify, call and question witnesses, make opening and closing statements, make objections, present evidence, and otherwise answer the charges contained in the Amended Suspension Statement; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council found Judge Yazzie responsible for an offense as alleged in the Amended Suspension Statement and suspended Judge Yazzie from Office for 60 days; and

WHEREAS, 6 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, Section 4105(I) provides that the "Council may by a separate vote reduce the suspension to a shorter period of not less than ten days."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it reduces the length of Judge Larry K. Yazzie's suspension from 60 days to 10 days effective immediately.

The foregoing Order was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH day of <u>SEPTEMBER</u>, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 742.85 FOR; 2,203.65 AGAINST; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(a) and 1(1); Article VIII, Section 3 and 4; and Article XIII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
