

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) Grant Agreement for FY
2014 with the United States Department of the Interior-National Park Service
and approving the FY 2014 budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 13-389

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") recognizes the need to protect, preserve**
2 **and manage cultural resources on its lands; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution 08-249, in part to**
4 **approve the Nation's application to establish a Tribal Historic Preservation**
5 **Office ("THPO") as part of the Nation's Cultural Affairs Program, pursuant to the**
6 **National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 ("NHPA") as amended (16 U.S.C. 470 *et***
7 ***seq.*); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation received notification from the National Park Service on September 4,**
9 **2009, that the Nation's application to establish a THPO for the Nation was**
10 **approved; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Nation received notification from the National Park Service that its grant**
12 **application to fund the Nation's THPO Office was approved in the amount of**
13 **\$75,990.00 for FY 2014; and**

14 **WHEREAS, a FY 2014 budget was prepared; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee and Budget and Finance Committee have**
16 **reviewed this grant agreement and budget and recommend approval by the**
17 **Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham does hereby approve the Grant**
19 **Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto, with the United States**
20 **Department of the Interior, National Park Service and approves the budget in**
21 **the amount of \$75,990.00 for FY 2014.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
23 **Chairperson of the Tohono O'odham Nation to execute the Grant Agreement and**
24 **any designated official to expend and administer the budget as attached,**
25 **provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is submitted**
26 **for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH**
28 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,705.5**
29 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 241.0[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
30 **Council Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
31 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
