

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement between the Pascua
Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 13-443

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) has negotiated a Mutual Protection and**
2 **Law Enforcement Agreement with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe (Tribe); and**

3 **WHEREAS, this Agreement will allow both Parties to assist and aid the other Party when**
4 **necessary for the purposes of enforcing federal, state, and tribal criminal laws;**
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, this Agreement will allow both Parties to detain and hold individuals suspected**
7 **of committing crimes in the other Party's jurisdiction until the other law**
8 **enforcement Party arrives; and**

9 **WHEREAS, as needed each Party will share information on patrol operations, narcotics**
10 **investigations and all related criminal activities that may occur in each other's**
11 **jurisdiction; and**

12 **WHEREAS, this Agreement shall not be construed to cede any jurisdiction of either Party or**
13 **to waive either Party's sovereign immunity in any forum or jurisdiction; and**

14 **WHEREAS, this Agreement is for a term of five (5) years and may thereafter be renewed by**
15 **further action of the Legislative Council; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Agreement has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs Committee, which**
17 **recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
19 **approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement between the**
20 **Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation substantially in the form**
21 **attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute it.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH**
23 **day of NOVEMBER, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5**
24 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
25 **Council by Article VI, Section 1 (Dand1(c)(6) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
27 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
28 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
