RESOLUTION NO. 13-489

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded the Department of Justice (DOJ),**
2 **Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) Project Safe**
3 **Neighborhood Initiatives, grant #2011-GP-BX-0030; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the grant was accepted by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by**
5 **Resolution No. 11-540; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the grant effective dates were from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Nation requested a grant extension; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation has been approved for the grant extension for a period of one year**
9 **effective July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this grant allows for Indirect Cost charges; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has prepared a budget of which**
12 **has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants & Contracts, Executive Office,**
13 **Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, all of which**
14 **recommend acceptance by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
16 **approves the FY 2014 grant extension of the DOJ/OJP TON Project Safe**
17 **Neighborhood Initiative grant, grant #2011-GP-BX-0030 in the amount of**
18 **\$75,995.65 to include Indirect Cost.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
20 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**
21 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or**
22 **funding level shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
23 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH**
25 **day of DECEMBER, 2013 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.50**
26 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
27 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
28 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
29 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of**
30 **the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
