

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Amendment #1 to the Natural Resources Department Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation Cultural Center & Museum FY 2014 Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-098**

1 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Center Museum's FY 2104 Budget was approved with Resolution**  
2 **number 13-277; and**

3 **WHEREAS, line item Program Supplies Narrative of this budget ("Supplies used directly by**  
4 **or for program members, clients or participants") does not provide for**  
5 **collections acquisition options; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Program Supplies line item Narrative shall be modified to provide**  
7 **additional justification inclusive of relevant acquisition options with an added**  
8 **clause reading "Covers expenses for relevant collections to be retained in the**  
9 **possession of Himdag Ki:"; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this amendment also includes a change in amounts to line items but does not**  
11 **affect the original amount of the Budget; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of**  
13 **the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval**  
14 **and adoption.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
16 **approves Amendment #1 to the Cultural Center & Museum Budget amending the**  
17 **Narrative to the Program Supplies line item and adjusting amounts within line**  
18 **items per the Budget attached hereto.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**  
21 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
23 **Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>**  
25 **day of MARCH, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
27 **Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
28 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**  
30 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
