8	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 12 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1, Article X, Section 11002
9		removal upon accusation proceedings are commenced "by the filing with the
10		chairperson of the Legislative Council a written, notarized statement stating the
11		offense(s) charged against the accused in ordinary and concise language and
12		signed by a registered voter or voters of the Nation."; and
13	WHEREAS,	March 21, 2014, registered voters Anthony Flores, Eric A. Molina, and Jolene B.
14		Garcia (the "Accuser") filed with the chairperson of the Legislative Council a
15		written, notarized statement for removal from office ("Accusation") against Hia-
16		Ced District Officials Chairwoman Christina B. Andrews, Vice-Chairman
17		Fernando Martinez Sr., Representative Sherry Serventi, Representative Brenda
18		Faville, Representative Delphina Cameron, and Representative Virginia Garcia
19		(the "Accused") alleging the Accused committed removable offenses; and
20	WHEREAS,	on March 26, 2014 the Legislative Conncil by Legislative Order No. 14-104
21		adopted Removal Hearing Procedures and set a removal hearing on the
22		Accusation for April 15-17, 2014; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Accused were personally served from March 26-29, 2014, more than ten days
24		before the removal hearing, with a written removal hearing notice, a copy of the
25		Accusation and attachments, and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
26		Removal Hearing Procedures; and
27	WHEREAS,	the Accused filed written disclosures of witnesses and evidence and numerous
28		pre-hearing motions and requests, which the Legislative Council and
29		chairperson decided; and
30	WHEREAS,	the Accused were provided copies of the Accuser's written motions and
31		disclosures of witnesses and evidence that were filed with the Council; and
32	WHEREAS,	at the Legislative Council's April 15-17, 2014 removal hearing, the Accused were
33		given the opportunity to be present, be represented by counsel, testify, call and
34		question witnesses, make opening and closing statements, make objections,
