RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Designating and Authorizing Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association Executive Director as the Nation's Certifying Officer for Purposes of NAHASDA and Other Housing Programs)

RESOLUTION NO. 14-251

1	WHEKEAS,	the Constitution of the Tonono O'odnam Nation ("Nation") vests the Legislative
2		Council with the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public
3		health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham
4		Nation and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council established the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association
6		("TOKA") as a separate tribal entity in accordance with Article VI of the
7		Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and pursuant to Legislative Council
8		Ordinance No. 98-03, as amended (TOKA Ordinance No. 98-03, 18 Tohono
9		O'odham Code Chapter 1); and
10	WHEREAS,	the TOKA is (1) designated as the Nation's "Tribally Designated Housing Entity
11		("TDHE") in accordance with the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-
12	ĺ	Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. §4101, et seq., P.L. 104-330, 110 Stat. 4106
13		("NAHASDA") to implement the Nation's Indian Housing Plan under NAHASDA's
14		Indian Housing Block Grant ("IHBG") Program", and (2) established for the
15		primary purpose of providing well constructed and affordable homes for the
16		members, as well as maintaining the current assisted stock of home ownership
17		and rental homes (18 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Statement of Purpose and Article I.1.);
18		and
19	WHEREAS,	TOKA's Executive Director is expressly vested with the power "to enter into
20		agreements, contracts and understandings with any local, state or federal
21		governmental agencies" and "to apply for and to expend and obligate the funds
22		according to the contractual agreements, in order to effectively manage the
23		business and program affairs of the organization and to enhance community
24		development" (18 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Article VII, 1(a) and 1(b)); and
25	WHEREAS,	to improve TOKA operations for the Nation's benefit, it is necessary to clarify the
26		responsibilities and authorities of the TOKA in any housing program that (i)
27		involves TOKA's receipt, use and expenditure of federal or state housing funds or
28		proceeds for and on behalf of the Nation; and (ii) requires TOKA's compliance
29		and certification of compliance on behalf of TOKA and/or the Nation with
30		applicable federal environmental laws and regulations and related actions.

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- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, notwithstanding any contrary provision of 18 T.O.C. Chapter 1, designates and authorizes the TOKA Executive Director as the Nation's "Certifying Officer" as that term is defined in 24 CFR § 58.2(a)(2) for and on behalf of the Responsible Entity who is empowered to:
 - certify the TOKA's satisfaction of and compliance with the TOKA's 1. responsibilities in relation to the federal government's environmental review process applicable to the TOKA's receipt, use and expenditure of (a) federal and state housing grant funds; (b) proceeds of federally guaranteed loan programs; and (c) financing proceeds from federal and/or state low-income tax credit programs (collectively referred to as "Federal and State Housing Funds");
 - 2. execute any documents required or as may be reasonably necessary to implement the intent of this resolution, including documents for the Request for Release of Funds and Certification for Federal and State Housing Funds; and
 - 3. consent to and accept on behalf of TOKA, the jurisdiction of the federal courts for the limited purpose of enforcing federal regulatory responsibilities arising from and compliance with the federal government's environmental review/assessment process related and applicable to TOKA's receipt, use and expenditure of Federal and State **Housing Funds.**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that nothing in this resolution shall be construed as authorizing federal court jurisdiction over the Tohono O'odham Nation or a waiver of the Nation's sovereign immunity.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19^{TH} day of JUNE, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,974,30 FOR; 972.20 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
