

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2015 Budget for the U. S. Department of Justice, Community
Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant No. 2013-UM-WX-0010)**

RESOLUTION NO. 14-473

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) applied for and was awarded the U.S.**
2 **Department of Justice (DOJ), Community Oriented Policing Service (COPS)**
3 **Hiring Program Grant No. 2013-UM-WX-0010 with effective dates of September 1,**
4 **2014 through August 31, 2015; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the grant was accepted by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by**
6 **Resolution No. 14-062; and**

7 **WHEREAS, this grant requires a match that has been identified in the Tohono O'odham**
8 **Nation's Police Department's FY 2015 Tribal Law Enforcement Budget; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the three (3) Police Officer positions salary will be cost shared with the Law**
10 **Enforcement Tribal budget at 43.19% and 56.81% with the COPS Hiring Grant;**
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for Indirect Cost; and**


13 **WHEREAS, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the**
14 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
15 **adoption.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
17 **approves the FY 2015 Budget for the U.S. DOJ, COPS Hiring Program grant in the**
18 **amount of \$125,000.00; effective September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015 with**
19 **no Indirect Cost and a salary cost share of 43.19% with the FY 2015 Tribal Law**
20 **Enforcement Budget and 56.81% with the COPS Hiring Grant.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
22 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**
23 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or**
24 **funding level shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD**
27 **day of NOVEMBER, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR;**
28 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
32 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


