

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving carry forward of the US Department of Homeland Security, FEMA, Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Grant No. FEMA-1888-DR-AZ-Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 14-490

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency**
2 **Management Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants to states and tribes to fund**
3 **purchases that provide public safety services within their respective jurisdictions;**
4 **and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation submitted an application in FY2012 to FEMA for**
6 **direct funding and was awarded funding for Mitigation Education and Outreach**
7 **which required a Twenty-Five (25%) Tribal Match and waived the indirect costs to**
8 **administer the grant; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved through Resolution 13-055 the**
10 **acceptance of Hazard Mitigation Grant Program No. FEMA-1888-DR-AZ-Tohono**
11 **O'odham Nation awarded funds; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program of the Tohono O'odham Nation maintains**
13 **unobligated funds to be expended as part of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program**
14 **for Mitigation Education and Outreach; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management has submitted a FY 2015 budget to expend**
16 **unobligated funds; and**

17 **WHEREAS, Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the**
18 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
19 **adoption.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
21 **and authorizes the Office of Emergency Management to expend the unobligated**
22 **funds from the Hazard Mitigation Grant program No. FEMA-1888-DR-AZ-Tohono**
23 **O'odham Nation in the amount of \$8,252.36 and to utilize the Nation's resource**
24 **pending reimbursement from the grantor and the required Twenty-Five Percent**
25 **(25%) Tribal Match from FY 2015 Budget Account #001-15-5080.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program shall be expended in**
27 **accordance with the terms of the grant for the Budget period of 04/12/2012 to**
28 **04/09/2015 and further waives the indirect costs to administer this grant.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
30 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
31 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
32 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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
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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH
