## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving a Limited Waiver of the Sovereign Immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise in favor of Hunt-PENTA West Valley Resort)

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-512** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a federally recognized Indian tribe
2		organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934
3		(48 Stat. 984; 25 U.S.C. § 476), which exercises sovereignty over both its members
4		and its lands; and
5	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article VI of the Nation's Constitution, the Tohono O'odham
6		Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is vested with all of the legislative
7		powers of the Nation and is empowered to enact laws, ordinances, and resolutions
8		necessary or incidental to the exercise of its legislative powers; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council of the Nation has enacted an Ordinance for Regulation of
10		Gaming Activities Within the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Gaming Ordinance"),
11		which ordinance was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 93-296 and amended by
12		Resolution 97-150, Resolution 97-168, Resolution 97-303, Resolution 99-206,
13		Resolution No. 03-084, and Resolution 07-300 (16 T.O.C. Chapter 1); and
14	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Ordinance provides that all gaming activities conducted within the
15		Nation shall be owned entirely by the Nation and conducted and operated by a
16		tribal enterprise; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise (the "Gaming Enterprise") is a tribal
18		governmental enterprise of the Nation established pursuant to Article VI of the
19		Nation's Constitution as the tribal enterprise responsible for operating the
20		Nation's gaming facilities and conducting gaming activities in compliance with
21		the requirements of the Gaming Ordinance; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council adopted the Charter of the Gaming Enterprise (the
23		"Charter") by Resolution No. 93-311 and amended the Charter by Resolution 02-
24		294, Resolution No. 03-231, and Resolution 04-513 (16 T.O.C. Chapter 2); and
25	WHEREAS,	Section 5(d)(3) of the Charter charges the Gaming Enterprise with the
26		responsibility for planning, constructing, and management of all new or
27		additional gaming facilities; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Management Board is authorized to enter into, make, perform and carry out
29		contracts for any lawful purpose pertaining to the Enterprise's business (Charter,
30		Section 5(d)(10); and
31	WHEREAS,	Section 8(b)(2) of the Charter provides for a limited waiver of the Gaming
32		Enterprise's sovereign immunity with respect to claims based upon a written
33		contract to which the Gaming Enterprise is a party; and
34	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise entered into a Master Construction Agreement
35		("Agreement") on August 25, 2014 with Hunt-PENTA West Valley Resort ("Hunt-
36		PENTA"), a joint venture of Hunt Construction Group, Inc., an Indiana

(Approving a Limited Waiver of the Sovereign Immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise in favor of Hunt-PENTA West Valley Resort) Page 2 of 3 1 corporation, and The PENTA Building Group, LLC, a Nevada limited liability 2 company, for the purpose of engaging Hunt-PENTA as its general contractor for 3 the development and construction of TOGE's newest gaming facility on the 4 Nation's lands located near Glendale. AZ: and 5 WHEREAS, the Agreement was the result of significant negotiation between the parties and is 6 expressly conditioned upon a modification of the limited waiver of immunity 7 within Section 8(b)(2) of the Enterprise's Charter solely for purposes of the 8 Agreement and for the sole benefit of Hunt-PENTA West Valley Resort; and 9 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement with Hunt-PENTA, within 90 days of the execution of 10 the Agreement, TOGE must seek a modification of the statutory waiver in Section 11 8(b) that conforms to the requirements of Section 25 and Section 26 of the 12 Agreement: and 13 WHEREAS, the Enterprise is seeking approval from the Legislative Council for this 14 modification to the scope of the waiver of the TOGE's immunity pursuant to the 15 terms of the Agreement, which is incorporated by this reference; and 16 WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the language of 17 the proposed wavier under Sections 25 and 26 of the Agreement and believes it is 18 in the best interest of the Nation to adopt a resolution that approves those 19 modifications: and 20 WHEREAS, the Nation's best interest will be served by modifying TOGE's statutory waiver of 21 sovereign immunity as provided in the attached Exhibit A. 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grants a limited 23 waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise in 24 favor of Hunt-PENTA West Valley Resort solely for the purpose of compliance with 25 the covenants made in the Agreement and adopts the attached Exhibit A for that 26 purpose. 27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21st 28 day of NOVEMBER, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2.946.5 FOR; 29 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 30 Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the 31 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant 32 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of 33 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984). 34 35 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 36 37 38 mothy Joaquin, Legislative Chairman 39 40 41
