

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Designating the December 4, 2014 General Session for a Tour of the
Gila Bend Indian Reservation)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 14-521

1 **WHEREAS, +the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
6 **Council, as amended, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be**
7 **held at the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells,**
8 **Tohono O'odham Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the**
9 **legislative representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other**
10 **than the chambers located at Sells."; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee has requested the Legislative Council designate the**
12 **December 4, 2014 general session for a tour of the Gila Bend Indian Reservation**
13 **with roll call beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the San Lucy Village feast house.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
15 **designates the December 4, 2014 general session for a tour of the Gila Bend**
16 **Indian Reservation with roll call beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the San Lucy Village**
17 **feast house.**

18 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH day of**
19 **NOVEMBER, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
22 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
24 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
