RESOLUTION NO. <u>14-538</u>

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a Federally-recognized Indian
2		Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is
3		the governing body of the Nation; and
4	WHEREAS,	MAP-21 (Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century) authorizes the use of the
5		Tribal Transportation Bridge Program (TTBP) to carry out the planning,
6		engineering, preconstruction, construction, and inspection activities
7		associated with bringing structurally deficient and functionally obsolete IRR
8		bridges up to standard; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Fresnal Canyon Bridge (BIA Bridge No. H662) structure on BIA Route 10,
10		consisting of three-60 inch diameter CMP culverts and head walls, was
11		constructed in 1950, was washed out in 2004 and needs to be replaced to provide
12		an all-weather crossing over the Fresnal Canyon Wash; and
13	WHEREAS,	Bridge Number H662 has a sufficiency rating of 17.0 and is listed in the BIA
14		Bridge Inventory as structurally deficient and functionally obsolete which
15		makes it eligible for replacement using TTBP funds; and
16	WHEREAS,	TTBP funds are limited and it is urgent to obtain Tohono O'odham Legislative
17		Council approval for the Nation to submit the required application to receive
18		serious consideration for these critically needed funds; and
19	WHEREAS,	the estimated costs to perform tribal project management and essential
20		preliminary engineering work for a replacement bridge is \$103,500; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Nation is requesting the BIA to add this project to the Nation's Tribal
22		Transportation Improvement Plan to be eligible for these funds, and
23	WHEREAS,	the Nation intends to enter into a P. L. 93-638 design and construction contract
24		to provide labor, materials, equipment, and services necessary to complete the
25		road improvements and construction on this project; and
26	WHEREAS,	a qualified civil engineering consultant registered in the State of Arizona will be
27		selected in accordance with Public Law 112-141 Section 202 (b)(5) to perform
28		preliminary engineering activities (survey, bridge design, archeology,
29		environmental, and right-of-way) and develop a design concept report for BIA
30		Project PIR 10(1) Bridge H662 for the future construction of a new bridge at
31		Fresnal Canyon Wash to replace the washed out H662 bridge structure; and
32	WHEREAS,	an additional private civil engineer registered in the State of Arizona will be
33		selected by the Tohono O'odham Nation to perform second level reviews as
34		required; and

- the Commerce, the Appropriations and the Budget and Finance Committees of 1 WHEREAS, 2 the Legislative Council have reviewed the application to the Tribal 3 Transportation Bridge Program and recommend its submittal.
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby 5 approves the submittal of an application to the Tribal Transportation Bridge 6 Program (TTBP) to Fund Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Project PIR 10(1) Bridge 7 H662 for the future construction of a new bridge over the Fresnal Canyon Wash 8 on the Tohono O'odham Nation.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office, Division of Transportation include this project in the Nation's Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan.
- 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Nation requests that the Bureau of 13 Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office, Division of Transportation perform 14 their specific duties in the supplementary preparation and submittal of the 15 Tohono O'odham Nation application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, 16 Department of Transportation for strong consideration in the awarding of these 17 funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should application be awarded, the Tohono O'odham Nation 19 intends to enter into a P. L. 93-638 contract for preliminary engineering and 20 tribal project management in the amount of \$103,500 to perform survey, bridge design, archeology, environmental, and right-of-way studies to develop a design concept report under project PIR 10(1) Bridge H662 for the future construction of a new bridge at Fresnal Canyon Wash.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Chairperson or their designee is authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to fulfill the intent of this resolution.
