

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending the 2012 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) by adding the Preliminary Engineering of the existing Bridge at Fresnal Canyon to the 2014 TTIP)

RESOLUTION NO. 14-539

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the Nation) is Federal Recognized Indian Tribe and**
2 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the Legislative Council) is the**
3 **governing body of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation completed a Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) in**
5 **2008 that identified road improvement projects to meet long range (20-year)**
6 **Tribal transportation needs; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 08-372, dated June 20, 2008, that**
8 **prioritized road improvement projects identified in the 2008 through 2012 TTIP;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the 2012 TTIP to add the design and reconstruction of**
11 **the existing bridge (BIA Bridge #H662) at Fresnal Canyon on IR 10 to the 2014**
12 **TTIP.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
14 **amends the 2012 TTIP by adding the Preliminary Engineering of the existing**
15 **bridge (BIA Bridge #H662) at Fresnal Canyon on IR10 to the 2014 TTIP.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes**
17 **the BIA-Western Regional Office, Division of Transportation, to take the**
18 **necessary action to implement this project based on the Tribe's current road**
19 **construction priorities.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Nation's Chairperson or Vice Chairperson and any**
21 **designated officials are authorized to execute the documents necessary to fulfill**
22 **the intent of this resolution.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD**
24 **day of DECEMBER, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR;**
25 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1(j) of Article VII the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
27 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
28 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
29 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
