

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented
Policing Services Hiring Program Grant, Grant Award No. 2014UMWX0024 and
approval of the FY 2015 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 14-545

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and was awarded the Department of**
2 **Justice (DOJ), Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Hiring Program**
3 **Grant, Grant Award No. 2014UMWX0024 with a grant period of three years**
4 **effective September 1, 2014 thru August 31, 2017; and**

5 **WHEREAS, this grant will fund four Police Officer positions; and**

6 **WHEREAS, this grant requires a 57.38% match which has been identified in the FY 2015**
7 **Tribal Law Enforcement budget; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the match is effective for the 2015 budget cycle of October 1, 2014 thru**
9 **September 30, 2015; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for Indirect Cost Charges; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**
12 **Council have reviewed this budget and recommends its approval and adoption.**

13 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
14 **accepts the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing**
15 **Services Hiring Program Grant, Grant No. 2014UMWX0024 for a period of three**
16 **years effective September 1, 2014 thru August 31, 2017 to fund four Police Officer**
17 **positions with a matching cost of 57.38% identified under the FY 2015 Tribal Law**
18 **Enforcement Budget with effective dates of September 1, 2014 thru August 31,**
19 **2015.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
21 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**
22 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or**
23 **funding level is submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
26 **day of DECEMBER, 2014 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR;**
27 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
31 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
