7		Tribal Law Enforcement budget; and						
8	WHEREAS,	the match is effective for the 2015 budget cycle of October 1, 2014 thru						
9		September 30, 2015; and						
10	WHEREAS,	this grant does not allow for Indirect Cost Charges; and						
11	WHEREAS,	Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative						
12		Council have reviewed this budget and recommends its approval and adoption.						
13	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby							
14		accepts the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing						
15		Services Hiring Program Grant, Grant No. 2014UMWX0024 for a period of three						
16		years effective September 1, 2014 thru August 31, 2017 to fund four Police Officer						
17		positions with a matching cost of 57.38% identified under the FY 2015 Tribal Law						
18		Enforcement Budget with effective dates of September 1, 2014 thru August 31,
