## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Tribal Land Assignment for the West Valley Area)

RESOLUTION NO. 14-565

1	WHEREAS,	in 1986, the United States Congress enacted the Gila Bend Indian Reservation		
2		Lands Replacement Act as Pub. L. No. 99-503 (the "Replacement Act"), which		
3		authorized the Nation to acquire new lands to replace lands damaged by the		
4		Painted Rock Dam and required the United States to hold eligible replacement		
5		lands in trust for the benefit of the Nation; and		
6	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution No. 09-049, as amended by Resolution No. 09-397, the		
7		Legislative Council requested that the Secretary of the Interior acquire 134.88		
8		acres of real property (the "West Valley Area") in trust for the benefit of the		
9		Nation under the terms of the Replacement Act; and		
10	WHEREAS,	on July 3, 2014 the United States Department of the Interior issued a decision to		
11		acquire in trust on behalf of the Nation "Parcel 2," approximately 54 acres of		
12		land within the West Valley Area, and Parcel 2 is now held in trust by the United		
13		States for the benefit of the Nation and its members; and		
14	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise (the "Gaming Enterprise") is a wholly		
15		owned tribal government enterprise established pursuant to Article VI, Section		
16		1(e) of the Nation's Constitution and is responsible for planning, constructing,		
17		and operating the Nation's gaming facilities and conducting gaming activities		
18		(Charter of the Gaming Enterprise ("Charter"), 16 Tohono O'odham Code		
19		Chapter 2); and		
20	WHEREAS, Section 5(d)(6) of the Charter vests the Gaming Enterprise Management Boa			
21		with authority to "Utilize, improve, maintain, operate and manage, in the		
22		ordinary course of business, all interests in real property held by the Enterprise,		
23		including negotiation of leases or subleases of real property subject to approval		
24		of the Legislative Council; provided however, that nothing in this Charter shall		
25		be construed as authorizing the Enterprise to mortgage or encumber trust or		
26	:	restricted real property of the Nation without the prior consent of the Legislative		
27		Council"; and		
28	WHEREAS,	effective August 5, 2014, the Legislative Council by Resolution No. 14-318		
29		authorized the Gaming Enterprise to continue to utilize, improve, maintain,

The unallotted lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation and all lands 4 hereafter acquired by the nation, or held for the use of the nation or its 5 members, are a valuable public resource and shall be held as national 6 lands forever. Control and management thereof are vested in the Tohono 7 O'odham Council, which may enact laws governing the use, assignment, 8 permit, lease or other disposition of lands, interests in land and 9 resources of the nation consistent with Federal law. 10 (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article XVI, Section 1); and 11 WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to grant the Gaming Enterprise a tribal land 12 assignment for the national lands at the West Valley Area in accordance with the 13 existing assignment authority vested by Article VI, Section 1 and Article XVI, 14 Section 1 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation: and 15 WHEREAS. the Tribal Land Assignment for the West Valley Area, which is incorporated by 16 this reference, shall constitute a disposition authorized by the Legislative 17 Council, be non-exclusive in accordance with its terms, and have a term of six 18 years and 364 days; and 19 WHEREAS. the Tribal Land Assignment for West Valley Area has been reviewed by the 20 Commerce, Budget and Finance, and Agricultural and Natural Resources 21 Committees, which recommend that it be approved. 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves 23 the Tribal Land Assignment for West Valley Area in substantially the form 24 incorporated herein and authorizes and directs the Nation's chairperson to 25 execute the Assignment. 26 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tribal Land 27 Assignment for West Valley Area shall supersede and replace the terms of 28 Resolution No. 14-318, "Authorizing Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise to 29 Utilize, Improve, Maintain, Operate and Manage West Valley Resort Property," 30 effective January 1, 2015 except as otherwise provided in the Assignment.
