

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the May 25, 2018 Emergency Session Minutes)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 18-255

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council provide the
6 process for recording Legislative Council sessions and preparing summarized
7 minutes for review and approval by the Legislative Council and "approved
8 minutes shall become the official minutes and the property of the Tohono
9 O'odham Nation" (Legislative Rules, Article V); and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Rules, Article V, Section 2(C), "[a]ll summarized minutes
11 shall include the following: the title of each agenda item, presenter's name, and
12 for each legislative action shall include the action's title, the representative
13 making the motion and second, action number, and the vote count."; and

14 WHEREAS, the Legislative Secretary has presented a draft of the summarized minutes of the
15 May 25, 2018 emergency session for review and approval by the Legislative
16 Council; and

17 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has reviewed the minutes and made necessary
18 corrections.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20 May 25, 2018 emergency session minutes.

21 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH day of
22 JULY, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
23 -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,
24 Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
25 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
26 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
27 Stat.984).
