

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Sanitation Facilities Deficiency System Priority Ranking)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-362**

1 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Division of Environmental Health and Engineering**  
2 **(DEH&E) conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies, annually;**  
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an**  
5 **impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Service has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most**  
7 **critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of**  
8 **projects; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided**  
10 **recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the**  
11 **most critical needs; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and**  
13 **recommends approval of the four most critical and desirable priorities.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed**  
15 **and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following**  
16 **deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order of**  
17 **prioritization:**

- 18 1. **Water Service Line Replacement A**
- 19 2. **Tank Inspection and Repairs**
- 20 3. **Emergency Generator for Sells/Big Fields**
- 21 4. **Modular Bathroom - Water & Sewer-Group 2 - (Sites 39-50)**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>**  
23 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR;**  
24 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Article VI, Section 1 (j) and Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
27 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
28 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




