Indian Health Service has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most 7 critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of 8 projects; and 9 the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided WHEREAS. recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the 10 11 most critical needs; and 12 WHEREAS. the Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and 13 recommends approval of the four most critical and desirable priorities. 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed 15 and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following 16 deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order of 17 prioritization: 18 1. Water Service Line Replacement A 19 2. **Tank Inspection and Repairs** 20 3. **Emergency Generator for Sells/Big Fields** 21 4. Modular Bathroom - Water & Sewer-Group 2 - (Sites 39-50) 22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12^{TH} 23 day of SEPTEMBER, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; 24 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 25 Article VI, Section 1 (j) and Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy 26 27 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the 28 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 29
