

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to Submit a FY 2018 Indian Community Development Block Grant Application for New Housing Construction to the Department of Housing and Urban Development and to Confirm Compliance with Citizen Participation Requirements)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-473

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,**
3 **morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its**
4 **members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally**
6 **designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing**
7 **Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. §4101, et seq., P.L. 104-**
8 **330 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the Indian Housing**
9 **Block Grant and to seek other funds to operate and expand affordable housing;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, TOKA is a "tribal organization" that has been determined eligible to apply directly**
12 **for Indian Community Development Block Grant ("ICDBG") funds by the HUD**
13 **Southwest Office of Native American Programs, provided that the Tohono**
14 **O'odham Nation authorizes it to do so on its behalf (25 U.S.C. §450b; 24 C.F.R.**
15 **§1003.5); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the TOKA wishes to continue providing new affordable housing to meet the needs**
17 **of community members by submitting a FY 2018 ICDBG application for \$2,000,000**
18 **and leveraging those funds with Indian Housing Block Grant funds for new re-**
19 **construction of 20 low-income single-family housing units to serve and improve**
20 **the quality of life for tribal community members; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the FY 2018 Notice of Funding Availability ("NOFA") that prescribes application**
22 **requirements states there must be a current tribal resolution confirming**
23 **compliance with ICDBG Citizen Participation requirements and authorizing the**
24 **submission of the application by the TOKA; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the Nation held public meetings to discuss the ICDBG program and eligible**
26 **activities including the proposed project, obtained public comments, and made**
27 **modifications to the application as necessary in compliance with 24 CFR**
28 **§1003.604(a); and**

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1 **WHEREAS, the Housing Committee reviewed TOKA's 2018 ICDBG project proposal and**
2 **recommends approval.**


3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 4 **1. authorizes TOKA to submit a FY 2018 application for HUD ICDBG funding in**
5 **the amount of \$2,000,000 and to leverage funds with the Indian Housing**
6 **Block Grant to construct 20 new housing reconstructed units; and**
7 **2. confirms that the Nation has complied with the Citizen Participation**
8 **requirements of 24 CFR §1003.604(a).**

9 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and the**
10 **Nation's Chairperson to execute all documents necessary to submit and accept if**
11 **awarded the TOKA's FY 2018 application for HUD ICDBG funds.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH**
13 **day of DECEMBER, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR;**
14 **-0- AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
17 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
18 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
