7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe
8		and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is the
9		governing body of the Nation; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Nation was notified by the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA"), Western Regional
11		Office ("WRO") that it anticipates funds will be available for Transportation
12		Project 21(4) that runs approximately 11.524 miles on Route 21 from just below
13		Santa Cruz Community to Papago Farms; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Nation was given the right of first refusal to contract Project PIR 21(4) through
15		a P.L. 93-638 Self-Determination Contract; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Nation by letter dated November 30, 2018, which is incorporated by this
17		reference, has informed the BIA WRO of its intent to enter into a P.L. 93-638
18		contract to perform construction, engineering and management services for
19		Project PIR 21(4), and submitted the Nation's Program of Requirements ("POR")
20		listing the Nations' programmatic needs to complete the project as well as a
21		contract template that it recommends be used for the Nation's Project PIR 21(4)
22		P.L. 93-638 Contract; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the proposal to
24		enter into a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western
25		Regional Office for Transportation Project PIR 21(4) and recommends its
26		approval.
27	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and
28	-	authorizes the Nation to enter into a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of
29		Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office for Transportation Project PIR 21(4),
