

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 442

WHEREAS, An invitation has been extended by Earl L. O'Clair, Chief of Police, Phoenix, Arizona, to the members of the Papago Agency Police Force to attend the Phoenix Police Academy at South Mountain Park, Phoenix, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council desires wherever possible to give the members of its staff and officials of the Papago Council the opportunity to improve themselves through more training and instruction and therefore to become greater assets to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, It is felt that Espirito Adams, Chief of Police, can gain much by attending the Academy wherein is available the best instruction and training in the State of Arizona,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council, that Espirito Adams, Chief of Police, be permitted to attend the Phoenix Police Academy at South Mountain Park, Phoenix, Arizona for the period beginning January 9 and ending January 20, 1950, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in accordance with Resolution No. 394 of the Papago Council, Espirito Adams be allowed travel expenses at the rate of \$10.00 per day.

PROVIDED, That the per diem and lodging expense be paid from PT-8, Court Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3(a), of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
