

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 443

WHEREAS, Unforeseen needs have necessitated expenditures from the Budget of the Papago Council resulting in shortages in some of the Budget Accounts for the remainder of the Fiscal Year,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, That the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be instructed to request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to allot two thousand dollars (\$2,000) from the non-interest bearing funds being held to the credit of the Papago Tribe in the U. S. Treasury, and

Be It Further Resolved, That these funds shall be expended by the Superintendent upon the written authorization of the officers of the Papago Council for the purpose of supplementing the Fiscal Year 1950 Budget of the Papago Council as approved by Resolution No. 417 of the Papago Council.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3(a), of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
