

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 446

WHEREAS, The Papago Council by Resolution No. 391 approved the Papago Development Program on November 26, 1948, as expressing to the best of its belief the true facts of the present deplorable conditions on the Papago reservations and its considered recommendations for the improvements thereof, and

WHEREAS, The Superintendent of the Papago Agency, upon request of the Papago Council transmitted the program to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs on November 27, 1948, for presentation to the Congress of the United States, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Indian Affairs approved and submitted the Papago Development Program to the Secretary of the Interior on May 17, 1949, and

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior approved the Papago Development Program on May 24, 1949, and legislation is now being prepared for submission to the Congress,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Papago Council that Thomas A. Segundo, Alfred C. Garcia and Frank Pablo be appointed as a delegation to go to Washington to present to and justify the Papago Development Program before the proper committees in Congress,

PROVIDED, That the purchase of transportation for the delegation be made from funds appropriated from the U.S. Treasury for the Papago Tribe, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the sum of \$8.00 Per Diem be paid to each delegate from appropriated funds, a reasonable portion thereof to be advanced to the delegates; and

PROVIDED FINALLY, That the Chairman be authorized to make such arrangements as are necessary for the trip.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 5 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
