

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPERGO COUNCIL

NO. 453

WHEREAS, Delphina Angelo and Archie Hendricks have applied for loans of \$180.00 and \$300.00 respectfully, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 224 of the Papago Council states that "Loans for over \$150.00 shall be passed upon by the Board and presented to the Council for action, with the Board's recommendation," and

WHEREAS, The Papago Loan Board has recommended to the Papago Council that the loans be approved,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Papago Council that the loan application of Delphina Angelo for 180.00 to be paid back within 10 months at an interest rate of 5 % and that of Archie Hendricks for \$300.00 to be paid back within 12 months at an interest rate of 5%, be, and are hereby approved, such loans to be expended from Fund PT-11, Papago Loan Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
