

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 454

WHEREAS, Proper development of the Papago Reservation road system is essential to the progress of the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did, in its Papago Development Program, call for the reconstruction of the Quijotoa - Casa Grande road and of parts of the secondary road system to primary standards, and construction of additional school bus roads, net works of the irrigation projects, and access roads to villages, and

WHEREAS, The Roads Division of the Papago Agency has prepared a Long Range Road Program and Master Road Plan showing in detail the work called for in the Papago Development Program,

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the Long Range Road Program and Master Road Plan of the Papago reservations be approved as a supplement to the Papago Development Program, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be requested to submit the Long Range Road Program and the Master Road Plan to the Indian Office and the Bureau of Public Roads with our recommendations of approval,

PROVIDED, That since future growth and needs of the Papago Reservations are not completely foreseeable, the Papago Council reserves the right to recommend that certain roads not be constructed or that other roads be built, as future conditions may warrant.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2(d) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
