

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 455

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Reclamation, Parker Dam Power Project, has made application for a right-of-way for a transmission line across the San Xavier Reservation, and

WHEREAS, A portion of this right-of-way crosses tribal land at the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 23, T.15 R.13E, GRB&M, and

WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council has by its resolution of May 10, 1950 submitted its recommendation to the Papago Council that the Bureau of Reclamation, Parker Dam Power Project, be granted the requested right-of-way across the Tribal land within San Xavier District,


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Papago Council recommend to the Secretary of the Interior that said right-of-way be granted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Papago Council be authorized to enter into a contract with the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, Parker Dam Power Project for the right-of-way across said Tribal land upon the same terms as those agreed to by the individual allottees, one-half of the payment for damages, therefore, to be deposited in Account P-1 and one-half to be deposited to the credit of the San Xavier District Council.

The foregoing resolution was on May 19, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
