

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 458

WHEREAS, The Arizona State Employment Service, Farm Placement Division has provided opportunities for employment of Papagos in the Yuma farming area, namely Somerton, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, It was necessary to hire a truck and driver to transport the Papago workers to Somerton,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Juan Mattias be paid \$23.00 for twenty-three (23) hours driving time at the rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per hour from the General Fund, PT-1.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
