

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 460

WHEREAS, Certain expenses of the Papago Council have been greater than anticipated for the Fiscal Year 1950, so that some of the accounts in the Budget of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1950 were over-expended,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to transfer \$203.90 from PT-5A, Tribal Truck operations, maintenance and repairs, to PT-2, Travel expenses and pay allowances for delegates and officers; \$7.15 from PT-5A to PT-4, Salaries of Council Employees and \$238.13 from PT-5A to PT-6, Maintenance, Repairs, and improvements to the Tribal Community Building.

PROVIDED, That in accordance with Resolution No. 417 of the Papago Council the unobligated balances in the budget accounts shall revert to the General Fund PT-1 after the above-listed transfers have been made.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by the Papago Council by a vote 20 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
