NO. 461

WHEREAS, The Government licenses granted to the Indian Traders on the Papago Reservation will expire June 30, 1950,

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.


