

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Josephine T. Martinez, has applied for a loan of \$300.00, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 224 of the Papago Council, states that "Loans for over \$150.00, shall be passed upon by the Board and presented to the Council for action, with the Board's recommendation," and

WHEREAS, The Papago Loan Board has recommended to the Papago Council, that the loan be approved,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that the loan application of Josephine T. Martinez, for \$300.00 be approved, payable within 12 months at an interest rate of 5%, said amount will be expended from the Papago Loan Board Fund PT-11.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by the Papago Council Resolution #224, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on March 7, 1944, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
