

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 463

WHEREAS, The Papago Council on March 17, 1950 approved the establishment of a District and Tribal Brand Program, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has instructed that a plan of operation be drawn up and submitted for consideration by the Council,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the Chairman be authorized to appoint a Tribal Brand Committee and instruct it to formulate a plan of operation which when approved by the Papago Council will be enacted as an Ordinance.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
