

RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 466

WHEREAS, On January 6, 1950, the Papago Council by Resolution 446 appointed Thomas A. Segundo, Alfred C. Garcia, and Frank Pablo as a delegation to go to Washington to present to and justify the Papago Development Program before the proper Committees in Congress, and

WHEREAS, Frank Pablo has notified the Council that he will be unable to make the trip with the delegation thereby creating a vacancy in the delegation.

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Jose Ignacio of Sells District be appointed to fill the vacancy created by Frank Pablo.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 9 for and 8 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
