

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Papago Loan Board expenses are paid from Account PT-12, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Loan Board has recommended to the Papago Council that, in order to provide adequate working capital, a transfer in the amount of \$2,400.00 be made from Account PT-11, Papago Tribal Loan Fund, to Account PT-12, Papago Tribal Loan Board Expenses.

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to transfer \$2,400.00 from PT-11, Papago Tribal Loan Fund, to PT-12, Papago Loan Board Expenses, to provide for authorized salary and other expenses.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
