

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 470

WHEREAS, Ida N. Wilson, Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council has submitted her resignation as such, effective at the expiration of sick leave which will begin July 31, 1950,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the resignation of Ida N. Wilson be accepted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Alfred C. Garcia, Loan Board Manager, be appointed Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council to fill the vacancy.

PROVIDED, That an appointment to the position of Loan Board Manager be made by the Papago Council before July 31, 1950.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
