THE PAPAGO COUNCIL


WHEREAS, It was necessary to provide transportation for Papagos working in the Somerton farming area for their return to the Papago Reservation,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Juan Mattias be paid \$16.00 for sixteen (16) hours driving time at the rate of \$1.00 per hour from the General Fund, PT-1.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by the Papago Council by a vote of 20 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
