

RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 477

WHEREAS, Alfred Heeden, was hired to supervise the work on the Papago Tribal Adobe Units, a project for the American Friends Service Committee's work Camp, which will serve as overnight stopping places and concession booths,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Papago Council that authorization is hereby given to pay Alfred Heeden for his services to the Papago Council at the rate of \$2.00 per hour and in accordance with the certified time sheets submitted,

PROVIDED, That such payment shall be made from MT-7, Miscellaneous Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984) Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
