

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAFAGO COUNCIL

No. 478

WHEREAS, It is expected that the expenditures from the Budget of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1951, will be heavy,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Papago Council, that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be instructed to request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to allot two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) from the non-interest bearing funds being held to the credit of the Papago Tribe in the U. S. Treasury, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That these funds shall be expended by the Superintendent upon the written authorization of the officers of the Papago Council, for the purpose of supplementing the Fiscal Year 1951 budget of the Papago Council, as approved by Resolution No. 467 of the Papago Council.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 964). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
