

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 150

WHEREAS, The Papago Council by Resolution No. 457 authorized the purchase of a 300 B Ideal Vendor from the Nehi Beverage Company of Tucson, Arizona for installation in the Tribal Building, and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to establish a separate fund wherein would be deposited the proceeds from the sale of soft drinks and from which expenditures relative to the sale of the soft drinks may be made,

THEREFORE, BE it resolved by the Papago Council that Account PT-20, Vending Machine Proceeds and Sales be set up and all deposits from the proceeds of the sale of soft drinks made into said Account PT-20,

PROVIDED, That the Fund PT-20, Vending Machine Proceeds and Sales shall be a revolving fund.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
