WHERFAS, Submission of the PT-10 Budget has been delayed, and

WHEREAS, Travel expenses and pay allowances for the members of the Papago Livestock Board are paid from the said PT-10 Budget,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved that "Philbert Toro, Alonzo Moreno, Julio Francisco, Joaquin Harris, Ramon Chavez, and Johnson Pablo be paid for the scheduled meeting on July 6, 1950, and

BE IT FURTHER REBOLVED, That Philbert Toro, Joquin Harris and Alonzo Moreno be paid travel allowance for the scheduled meeting on August 3, 1950.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by the Papago Council by a vote of <u>17</u> for and <u>0</u> against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the reacission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
