

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 482

WHEREAS, The Papago Council prepared the Papago Development Program which was submitted and recommended for approval by Papago Council, Resolution 391 adopted November 26, 1948, and

WHEREAS, The Program was approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs and forwarded to the Secretary of the Interior under date of May 17, 1949, and was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 24, 1949, and

WHEREAS Papago Council Resolution 446 amended by Resolution 466 appointed a delegation of three members of the tribe to present and justify the Program to the committees of Congress, and Resolution 446 authorized transportation and per diem allowance, and

WHEREAS, The Council was advised by Congressman Patton of Arizona in his letter dated August 2, 1950, that hearings by the Congressional committees are scheduled for August 18 through August 21, 1950

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved By the Papago Council that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs is requested to authorize the Papago Delegation to proceed to Washington to attend the hearings on H. R. 8984, as scheduled. And that in addition to the request for tribal funds by Council Resolution 478, the Council now requests the Commissioner to advance \$1,000 from Tribal Funds now held by the United States to the credit of the Papago Tribe, for the purpose of paying the expenses of the Papago Delegation as prescribed in Resolution 446.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Papago Council requests that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs authorize the Superintendent of the Papago Agency to accompany the Papago Delegation to Washington, and that the expense of the Superintendent be paid from appropriated Government funds.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
