

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 485

WHEREAS, Alfred C. Garcia, has submitted his resignation as Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council, with the request that such resignation be effective August 16, 1950,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council, that the resignation of said Alfred C. Garcia, be accepted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That lump sum payment be made to Alfred C. Garcia, for accumulated annual leave days in accordance with Resolution No. 467, of the Papago Council,


PROVIDED, That such lump sum payment shall be made from Fund PF-4, Salaries of Tribal Council Employees.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 1937, pursuant to Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
