

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NC. 488

WHEREAS, Alfred C. Garcia resigned as Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council on August 16, 1950, thereby creating a vacancy in that position,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Priscilla R. Garcia be appointed to the position of Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council at a salary of \$175.00 per month, such appointment to be effective August 16, 1950,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Priscilla R. Garcia give bond to the Papago Tribe for the faithful performance of her duties in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) PROVIDED, That the premium on the bond to the Papago Tribe be paid from PT-3.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e), 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
