

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 489

WHEREAS, The Papago Council by Resolution No. 474 appointed Mark Manuel Loan Board Manager at a salary of \$150.00 per month effective August 31, 1950, and

WHEREAS, It is required that said Mark Manuel give bond to the Papago Tribe,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Mark Manuel give bond to the Papago Tribe for the faithful performance of his duties in the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.00), PROVIDED, That the premium on the bond to the Papago Tribe be paid from PT-12.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (a), 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
