

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 490

WHEREAS, Henry Jose was appointed by the Papago Livestock Board and the Papago Council to undertake on September 1, 1948 training under the Veterans Administration's training program at the Papago Tribal Herd Ranch with the understanding that such training and instruction continue until December 1, 1950, and

WHEREAS, It was the intent of the Papago Council that Henry Jose be sufficiently trained to take over the administration of the Tribal Herd Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, Alvin D. Knisely, Tribal Herd Foreman, has resigned effective July 31, 1950, thereby creating a vacancy in that position,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Henry Jose be appointed Tribal Herd Foreman at a salary of \$175.00 per month, such appointment to be effective August 1, 1950 and such salary to be paid from the Annual Budget of the Papago Tribal Herd, Fund PT-9,

PROVIDED, That the training program of Henry Jose be terminated as of August 1, 1950, whereupon, said Henry Jose shall cease to be a trainee under the Veteran's Administration's training program and shall assume full status as a Tribal Herd employee, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, That the salary of Jose Juan, Tribal Herd Rider, be raised from \$110.00 to \$150.00 per month, such salary to be paid from the Fund Pt-9, Papago Tribal Herd, as provided by the Annual Budget of the Papago Tribal Herd.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 1937, pursuant to Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
