

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 493

WHEREAS, The Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council has in the past also acted as Manager of Arts & Crafts, and

WHEREAS, The activities of the Arts & Crafts department increases in such proportion during the fall and winter months so that the work of the Secretary and Treasurer is seriously hampered,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Anita Antone of Sells be appointed Manager of Arts & Crafts at a salary of \$125.00 per month,

PROVIDED, That such salary be paid from the Arts and Crafts Fund, and PROVIDED, Further that the appointment be effective August 31, 1950 and that it continue until terminated by the Papago Council, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Anita Antone shall be hired with the full understanding that the Papago Council shall reserve the right to give her leave without pay during the slack periods in accordance with the fluctuations of the Arts & Crafts activities, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, That Anita Antone shall give bond to the Papago Tribe in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for the faithful performance of her duties, PROVIDED, That the premiums be paid from the Arts & Crafts Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1950, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to Authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e), 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.


