RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 603

WHEREAS, Deficiencies have resulted in certain accounts while unobligated balances are anticipated in other accounts in the Budget of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1952,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be instructed to transfer \$500.00 from Account PT-2, Travel expanses, delegates and officers, to Account PT-3, Office supplies and expanses; \$1,500.00 from Account PT-4, Salaries, Tribal Employees, to Account PT-5A, Tribal truck operations, maintenance and repairs; \$731.00 from Account PT-7, Emergency fund, to Account PT-6, Maintenance, r pairs and improvements to Community building.

PROVIDED, That at the end of the Fiscal Year 1952 any unobligated balance in any one of the Fiscal Year 1952 Budget Accounts of the Papago Council shall revert to the General Fund, PT-1.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 15 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
