RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 604

WHEREAS, Vacancies have occurred in the membership of the Papago Loan Board as a result of the resignation of Virginia Jose, and the automatic dismissal of Louis Harvey for failure to attend three consecutive meetings in accordance with Ordinance No. 20 of the Papago Council.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Gracia Gonzales and Anita Antone be appointed to fill the vacancies in the membership of the Papago Loan Board.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
